**Introduction**

Sergeant Mosley was hired by the Washington State Patrol on July 5, 2005. She attended the 15<sup>th</sup> Trooper Cadet Arming class and the 92<sup>nd</sup> Trooper Basic Training Class. On February 10, 2006, she graduated and was commissioned as a Trooper by Washington State Governor Christine Gregoire, Washington State Patrol Chief Batiste, and Washington State Supreme Court Chief Justice G. Alexander.

After being commissioned by the Washington State Patrol, Sergeant Mosley was assigned to the Field Operations Bureau in District 2; Bellevue for 7 years. This area is patrolled by 4 detachments of approximately 36 Troopers and 4 Sergeants. It's one of the busiest APA's in the state.

Sergeant Mosley was promoted to Corporal October 1, 2013 and was assigned to the Criminal Justice Training Commission (CJTC) in Burien as a TAC officer for the Basic Law Enforcement Academy (BLEA). She was the lead traffic instructor for over 390 recruits.

Sgt. Mosley is a certified Standardized Field Sobriety Test and BAC/PBT Instructor. She taught the SFST and BAC/PBT basic class to over 330 recruits; approximately 440 hours of classroom and practical instruction. Sgt. Mosley has organized and run over 22 wet labs. She completed Instructor Development II class in October 2014.

Sergeant Mosley was promoted to Sergeant on October 1, 2014 and is assigned to the Impaired Driving Section in Seattle as a Breath Test Program (BTP) Sergeant. She was certified as a BAC technician September 2015. Responsibilities include overseeing the BTP and supervising 6 Breath Test Technicians, covering 18 counties on the western side of Washington. Sergeant Mosley is the Technical Lead and helps to ensure the BTP is in compliance with the American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors/Laboratory Accreditation Board (ASCLD/LAB).

Sergeant Mosley graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Rhode Island in 1993.
