### **Program Responsibilities**

#### **Sergeant Crandall:**

- Manages DEC Program for Washington State including training and administrative sections;
- Works directly with IACP to ensure all International Standards are followed and adhered to;
- Manages Washington Traffic Safety Commission grant funds
- Manages reimbursements for Allied Agency DREs.

#### **Administrative Staff:**

- Coordinates all aspects of DRE certifications; beginning with original certification to 2-year certification, decertification, reinstatements, and lateral officers moving in and out of Washington State.
- Contact for DREs for equipment replacement; maintains inventory, orders supplies and equipment.
- Manages allied agency Memos of Understanding (MOUs) for overtime reimbursement
- Compiles statistics for the DEC Program for the Impaired Driving Section and IACP.
- Manages DRE database.
- Coordinates information on the DRE page of the Breath Test Program's website.
