On October 4, 1989, WSP detectives investigated a two car fatality collision on SR 164 just outside the City of Enumclaw. The causing driver, Ramon Prado Ochoa, was traveling towards Enumclaw when he crossed the center line and struck a vehicle head on killing the driver of the other car. Ochoa then fled the scene on foot; Ochoa's passenger identified Ochoa as the driver and advised investigators that Ochoa had been drinking at the time of the collision. Ochoa told family members and friends he was going to go to Mexico. Ochoa was charged with Vehicular Homicide and Felony Hit and Run but never showed up for court. On October 10, 1989, a warrant was issued by the King County District Court.
