**DORMITORY RULES**



**1. Parking**

- a. The main parking lot is available for all dormitory users.

**2. Dormitories**

- a. Be sure doors are unlocked when leaving rooms.
- b. Do not open windows – climate control will be disrupted.
- c. Beds may be made up using the clean sheets and blankets provided.
- d. At the end of the week or when training is concluded, place used linen in the cart located in the laundry room. Unless your blanket is soiled please leave it on your bed.
- e. Obtain clean linen from Laundry Room and place on the bed for incoming students.
  - 1) Please leave blankets and linens folded on the bed similar to how you found them.
  - 2) Do not remove the mattress covers from the bed.
- f. Remove personal items from rooms by 8:30 a.m. on last day of training.
- g. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- h. Changing room assignments shall not be permitted without prior approval from staff personnel.
- i. Nothing shall be displayed on any dorm room wall or door without prior approval from staff personnel.
- j. Coeducational living regulations:
  - 1) All interaction between male and female students will be strictly professional.
  - 2) No male or female students are to share the same room.
  - 3) All students will abide by sexual harassment laws, policies, and state regulations.
  - 4) Any improper interaction between students shall result in disciplinary action.
  - 5) No student will enter the closed room of another without first knocking and receiving permission to enter.
  - 6) Students will be properly clothed when in public areas of the dorm.
    - (a) Uniform.
    - (b) Normal everyday street wear.
    - (c) Sweat suit or gym clothing.
    - (d) Full-length robe of a conservative nature.

### 3. Messages/Telephones

Non-emergency messages will be left on the bulletin board located in the Common Room.

### 4. General Rules

- a. **No alcoholic beverages** or nonprescription drugs are permitted on the campus.
- b. No one shall return to the Academy under the influence of alcohol.
- c. Videotapes/DVD's (movies)
  - 1) Be aware of the content of any rented movie—all must be appropriate for the workplace (no X, Hard R, or NC-17).
- d. Students shall not bring unauthorized visitors into the Dormitory or assigned room.
- e. NO SMOKING or tobacco use in any of the buildings or within 25' of any door or breezeway.
- f. Please help us keep the facility clean and professional.
  - 1) No food or drinks are permitted in the sleeping quarters.
    - A. NO appliances in the sleeping quarters (coffee makers, microwaves, popcorn makers etc)
  - 2) Pick up after yourself, especially the common areas.
    - A. Dorm room must at all times be clean and orderly.  
(Clothes put away, trash picked up, beds made, toiletries put away)
  - 3) The Common Room area shall be cleaned and straightened up prior to all students retiring for the night.
- g. Personnel protective equipment shall not be permitted in the dormitory.

NOTE: Video cameras are installed in the common areas; however they are not monitored and should not be relied on for emergency notification.
