

## Hazardous Materials Training



The Hazardous Materials Training Unit provides hazardous materials training to the first response community throughout the state of Washington through courses ranging from Hazardous Materials Awareness to Hazardous Materials Technician.

The Section also provides support to the Washington State Patrol with training and technical assistance with hazardous materials. As described in [RCW 70.136.030](#), the Washington State Patrol is designated as the Incident Command Agency in any hazardous materials incident on or along any state or interstate highway, as well as where they are designated by the local jurisdiction. The Washington State

Patrol is also directed by [RCW 70.136.035](#) to provide assistance at the scene of hazardous materials incidents where a separate agency is designated as the incident command agency.

Hazardous Materials Awareness, Operations, Technician, Chemistry, On-Scene Incident Command and other hazardous materials training is funded by the [Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness](#) (HMEP) program from USDOT and the Emergency Management Preparedness Grant (EMPG) from FEMA.
