COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT



KCFTOA Pump Operator Academy

This course provides knowledge and skills essential to pump operator's performing their duties at emergency incidents. The curriculum is based on objectives from Chapter 5 of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator Standard 1002. The course includes responsibilities of pump operators in maintaining a continuous water supply, hydraulics and friction loss factors, setting of pressure regulating devices and use of vehicle cooling accessories, proper fire streams pressures, pump panel practices, drafting operational procedures, and operation of a fire pump at a fire hydrant with low residual pressure. This forty-hour course heavily emphasis field demonstrations and practice sessions, it will include relay pumping operations.
