

AIRCRAFT RESCUE FIRE FIGHTING TRAINING PROP (ARFF)

The Washington State Fire Training Academy offers a unique training location for aircraft rescue firefighting. Located just off Interstate 90, is the home of the first state-of-the-art Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting trainer prop in the Pacific Northwest. Built with the cooperation and joint funding of local airport fire departments, state government and the FAA, the prop is equipped to provide realistic hands-on training using jet “A” fuel, while allowing the use of foam as an extinguishing medium. The operations plant separates the foam from the water/fuel run off and allows fuel and water to be reused.

The ARFF facility meets all of the requirements for providing FAA Airport A- BC- DE certification. In addition, the prop meets the Trans-Canada Aeronautic Airfield Requirements.

TRAINING INFORMATION

Training is available for half or full days. Additional charges are made for consumables, instructors and support personnel.

Half-day training including live hands-on firefighting is available at a cost of \$3,130.

Full-day training including live hands-on firefighting is available at a cost of \$5,690.

NFPA approved protective clothing, helmet, gloves and self-contained breathing apparatus with air cylinders within hydrostatic test date meeting current NFPA standards are required.

SUPPORT FACILITIES

The Fire Training Academy’s fifty-acre campus includes three classrooms, a cafeteria, fuel storage and distribution system, facilities maintenance building and student housing. A professionally trained staff of full and part time instructors delivers quality instruction on all aspects of firefighting.
