# COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

## BASIC FIREFIGHTER 1 ACADEMY

200 HOURS, 10 WEEKENDS

This program is designed for those individuals who wish to be trained to the NFPA Firefighter I level and are unable to attend the ten-week recruit academy. This course covers the basic fundamentals and prepares the participants for the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) certification exam. Successful candidates will receive IFSAC certification at the Firefighter I level, and Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations.

**PREREQUISITES:** High School graduate or GED, at least 18 years of age, First Aid and CPR certified, Completed and passed a physical agility evaluation within the past year. As well as passed a firefighter medical examination.

August 21 to November 1, 2009

**CLASS TIME:** Friday 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.  
Saturday and Sunday 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

**COST:** **\$1800** per student, **\$2070** out of state student

**CANCELLATIONS:** The Fire Training Academy must be notified in writing five (5) working days prior to the scheduled start date of the class or the full student fee will be assessed.
