Eight Hour

This 8-hour program introduces new firefighters to fire development theory as well as water application principals in order to effectively extinguish interior "Class A" fires. It is a program, which provides firefighters with the skills necessary to function as the nozzle operator of an interior fire attack team. Firefighters will work in a variety of fire situations utilizing direct, indirect and combination water application techniques. This curriculum meets WAC 296-305-05501 (2), and NFPA 1403 Fire Fighter I performance requirements.

PREREQUISITES: Meet requirements of NFPA 1403 (6.1.1) or be Fire Fighter I level trained.
