Auto Extrication - Operations

EIGHT HOUR, ONE-DAY CLASS

This comprehensive 8-hour class will involve 2-hours of classroom instruction that will introduce the student to the hazards associated with vehicle entrapment, air bags, seat belt pre-tensioners, vehicle stabilization, and new car construction. The next 5-hours on the drill ground will involve extensive hands on training in the use of hydraulic, hand tools and vehicle stabilization with telescoping struts in reality based scenarios. This is more than your average "take the doors and roof class".
