FIREFIGHTER II

80-Hours

This course prepares candidates for International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) Firefighter-II certification. Firefighters will receive instruction in incident size-up, auto extrication, flammable liquid firefighting, foam operations, fire prevention and investigation, small tools and equipment, and incident reports documentation. Upon completion of this course candidates will be offered the opportunity to participate in the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress Firefighter II certification testing.
