COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

FIRE INSPECTOR - 1

40 HOURS

This 40-hour program teaches students the concepts of fire inspection. The course includes hazard recognition, report writing, fire service professionalism, water supply requirements, occupancy classification, means of egress, suppression systems and inspection procedures. This course meets the competency standards established by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1031 (Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Inspector and Plan Examiner) 2003 Edition. Students who have the pre-requisites and successfully complete the course of instruction shall have the opportunity to participate in the International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) Fire Inspector I certification-testing process.

PREREQUISITES: Hazardous Material Awareness Level (NFPA 472)
Participation in a preparatory class on the International Fire Codes

REFERENCE TEXT: IFSTA Fire Inspection and Code Enforcement 6th Edition text, Study Guide, student workbook and handouts will be **provided**.
