FOUR DAY CLASS

This 32-hour program uses an intensive instructional methodology program to prepare the participant for planning and developing all aspects of course curriculum. The course also includes needs analysis, task analysis, course goals and objectives, lesson plan development, instructional support materials and evaluation instruments.

This course meets the competency standards established by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1041 Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications, Instructor 2. Upon successful completion students will receive an accredited NFPA Instructor 2 certificate and a certificate of level 2 certification.

PREREQUISITES: Students must be IFSAC Fire Instructor 1 certified. Bring to class an IFSTA Fire and Emergency Services Instructor, 6th Edition text. Student workbook and hand-outs will be provided.
