COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT

Flammable Liquids - 1

8 Hours

This program will supplement a firefighter's basic hose handling skills and knowledge base in dealing with flammable liquid "Class B" fire incidents. The class will include setting up foam firefighting equipment and the use of dry chemical extinguishing agents. Classroom presentations cover flammable liquid fuel properties, behavior of flammable liquids, capabilities of fire extinguishing agents, personnel safety, tactics and environmental concerns. This curriculum meets WAC 296-305-05501 (2), and NFPA 1403 performance requirements for Firefighter II level certification.

- PREREQUISITES: Sponsored by Fire Service Agency and/or enrolled in fire service educational program or course of study.
- CLASS DATES: April 18, 2009 October 3, 2009
- Class Time: 0830 – 1630
- CLASS SIZE: Class is limited to 24 students, and a minimum of 12 must enroll for the course to be taught.
