## Flammable Liquids – 2

8 Hours

During this program the students will be taught the basic properties of liquefied petroleum gasses, L.P.G. powered vehicle fuel systems, storage tanks and the safety features built into them, product identification and basic tactics for L.P.G. emergencies. The students will also participate in controlling live fires on a simulated horizontal storage tank, manifold and L.P. fill station.

**PREREQUISITES:** Met NFPA 1403 (6.1.1) Firefighter performance requirements or Firefighter I level trained.

Sponsored by Fire Service Agency and/or enrolled in fire service educational program or course of study.
