Search and Rescue 3 Rapid Intervention Team (RIT)

16 Hour Class

The class challenges firefighters to apply skills to remove themselves and others from situations that threaten their lives. The curriculum will review emergency use of SCBA, exiting a building using a hose line and radio procedures on how to declare a MAYDAY. Firefighters will learn and practice how to deploy a Rapid Intervention Team, as well as the utilization of Thermal Imaging Equipment in locating victims.

PREREQUISITES: Firefighter I level trained.
Successfully completed Search and Rescue 1

Class is limited to 20 students with a minimum of 12 for the course to be taught.
