One Car Rollover DUI

On 10-22-09 at 11:19 p.m. Washington State Patrol responded to a one car injury rollover collision on Pleasant Valley Road near Twin Oaks Road.

Jose L. Garcia a 40 year old, Chehalis resident was driving a 1999 Ford pickup westbound on Pleasant Valley road. The Ford pickup drifted on to the right shoulder. Garcia over corrected and the pickup crossed both east and westbound lanes of travel and onto the left shoulder. Garcia over corrected again and the pickup rolled several times in the eastbound lane. The pickup then crossed the westbound lane and left the roadway to the right, coming to rest in a field.

Garcia received injuries to his head, nose, and left shoulder. The passenger Dean A. Ferrians a 45 year old, Centralia resident received injuries to his head, and right arm. Both were transported to Providence Hospital.

Garcia was placed under arrest for DUI. A blood sample was taken to determine his blood alcohol concentration. When the results are obtained by the Toxicology Lab the case will be forward to the Lewis County Prosecutor for charging.
