WSP Trooper Arrests Driver for Reckless Driving, DUI, Suspended License, and Ignition Interlock violation

On 10/23/09 at 2:50 a.m. Trooper Stephen Robley arrested a driver for reckless driving, DUI, driving on a suspended driver's license, and violating an ignition interlock requirement.

Trooper Robley is part of the Patrols Statewide Aggressive Apprehension Team, and was driving an unmarked patrol. Robley was I-5 northbound near La Center traveling in the right lane, when he saw a car coming up behind him at a high rate. Robley activated his rear facing radar and obtained a reading of 121 miles per hour.

Tuy Khounphachansy a 35 year old, Vancouver resident, was driving a 2008 Infinity. After passed Robley's patrol car, Robley stopped him using his emergency lights and siren.

Robley immediately arrested Khounphachansy for Reckless Driving. While in custody Robley smelled the odor of intoxicates coming from his breath. A computer check of Khounphachansy showed his driver's license was suspended. It also showed he was required to have an ignition interlock system in his car, which it did not have.

Khounphachansy was booked into the Clark County Jail on charges of Reckless Driving, DUI, Suspended Drivers License, and violating Ignition Interlock requirement.
