RCW 46.25.123 Mandatory reporting of positive test.

All medical review officers or breath alcohol technicians hired by or under contract to a motor carrier or employer who is required to have a testing program under 49 C.F.R. 382 or to a consortium the carrier belongs to, as defined in 49 C.F.R. 382.17, shall report the finding of a commercial driver's confirmed positive drug or alcohol test to the department of licensing on a form provided by the department.

When a Washington Commercial Driver License (CDL) holder has a confirmed/verified positive drug or alcohol test either as a part of the testing program required by 49 C.F.R. 40 or a part of a pre-employment drug test, the Department of Licensing will disqualify the driver from driving a commercial motor vehicle.

The Report of Positive Drug/Alcohol Test for is for Employers and Motor Carriers to report refusals or confirmed/verified test results to the Department of Licensing. This form should be completed and submitted within three business days of the confirmed test. (RCW 46.25.123)

Employer Positive Test form

The Substance Abuse Professional Assessment/Treatment Report must be completed by a Department of Transportation (DOT) qualified Substance Abuse Professional (SAP). This form is required to release a CDL disqualification due to a refusal or positive DOT drug/alcohol test.

The form can be used to report the assessment, recommendation for treatment and whether a driver is satisfactorily participating or has successfully completed drug/alcohol treatment or education.
