Washington State Patrol Seeks Silver Mazda 3 from Hit and Run Collision

Snohomish County – On March 3, 2018 at approximately 12:37p.m, Washington State Patrol (WSP) responded to a two car Hit and Run Collision on State Route 96 at milepost 6. Upon arrival to the scene, the troopers observed a tan Toyota Camry in the eastbound ditch facing westbound; the Camry had struck a tree. The driver of the Camry sustained serious injuries and was transported to the hospital. Witnesses that remained on the scene told investigators that there was a silver Mazda 3 that crashed into the Camry causing it to go off the roadway. The Mazda fled the scene westbound from the collision.

During the on-scene investigation, detectives and troopers were able to collect a silver side mirror. It has been determined that the mirror is associated with a 2004-2009 Mazda 3 either four-door or five-door passenger vehicle. The color of the Mazda 3 is Sunlight Silver Effect.
