Detectives Seeking Information on a Fatal Hit and Run Collision

Kitsap County: At approximately 5:00am on Thursday, March 22, 2018, the Washington State Patrol (WSP) responded to reports of a hit and run collision at westbound SR 160 near Peppermill Place in Kitsap County. When troopers arrived they learned that a pedestrian had been struck and fatally injured by a westbound passenger vehicle. The pedestrian, a Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) ferry worker had just finished her shift and stopped to assist a disabled vehicle when she was struck.

WSP detectives have located and seized the running vehicle, described as a gold, 2002 Chevrolet Impala. The vehicle will be held as evidence and processed by the WSP crime lab for further evidence.

WSP detectives are seeking witnesses to this tragic collision or the driving of the Chevrolet Impala prior to the collision. Due to the timing of the collision and its proximity to the Southworth ferry dock, detectives would like to speak with anyone who may have observed the Chevrolet Impala or have in-vehicle video from a ferry crossing that arrived at the Southworth ferry dock at 4:50am on Thursday, March 22, 2018.
