Please submit the completed application through your respective state director or representative. They will direct the application to the trooper responsible for your geographical area. Do not submit this instructions page with your application.

If you have not submitted all of the requested items, the trooper will contact your state director or representative regarding the missing items. Incomplete applications delay processing.

A background check must be submitted from each state the applicant has resided in for the past five years. Criminal histories can be obtained through the Washington State Patrol Criminal History Section web site:

Please attach a copy of your current state-issued identification or driver's license and a copy of its current status. Washington State driver's license status can be obtained and printed from the Department of Licensing's web site:

Upon completion of all necessary requirements for certification, the WSP will issue the applicant an Ignition Interlock Technician Certification. This certification will be valid for one year from issuance and subject to all regulations of chapter 204-50 WAC. A paper certificate with the effective dates will be provided by the WSP. It will be routed through your state director or representative to you.

**To maintain your certification, please submit a new Technician Application with current documentation at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date.**
