The Washington State Patrol will continue to diligently work with our WSF and K9 partners in doing our best to ensure each traveler has a safe and enjoyable transit through our ferry system.

#### **Illegal fireworks\* include:**

Sky rockets

(Including bottle rockets)

Missile-type rockets

Chasers

Salutes

#### **Illegal explosive devices\* include:**

M-80, M-150, M-200, M-500, M-600, M-

1000, M-1300, M-3500

Tennis ball bombs

Homemade or altered fireworks
