Washington State Patrol Detectives Seeks Witnesses in Fatal Hit and Run Collision

Skagit County – On November 20, 2019 at approximately 1:18a.m., Tonya Pearson was struck and killed while she was walking in the southbound Interstate 5 (I-5) lanes near the Bow Hill rest area. Pearson was struck by a pickup truck and a semi-truck; the pickup truck did not remain on scene.

During the on-scene investigation, Washington State Patrol Troopers were able to collect several pieces of lighting material and a driver's side mirror which are believed to be from the pickup truck. It has been determined that the lighting material and mirror is associated with a 2008-2010 Ford Super Duty F-250, F-350 or F-450 that is possibly dark in color.

Washington State Patrol detectives are seeking any witnesses that may have information pertaining to this collision. We also had several 9-1-1 calls earlier in the evening regarding Pearson standing in the northbound lanes of I-5 near Bow Hill rest area.
