Sexual Assault Kit Tracking System

Report Requirement

Second Substitute House Bill 2530, adopted during the 2015 regular legislative session, and required Washington State Patrol (WSP) to submit a semiannual report beginning on January 31st, on the statewide sexual assault kit tracking system to the Joint Legislative Task Force and the appropriate committees of the legislature on sexual assault forensic examination best practices.

This report contains the following as required:

Sexual Assault Kits (SAKs) Collected - total number of active collected kits. Kits that have been discarded are not included in this count

SAKs Collected without Consent for Forensic Testing - total number of kits that have been collected where the survivor has not provided consent for forensic testing

SAKs Discarded - total number of kits destroyed or removed from the tracking system

SAKS Analyzed – total number of kits that have undergone forensic analysis and returned to the appropriate law enforcement agency

Total Collected SAKs in the System – total number of collected kits, including those that have been discarded

SAKs Analysis Backlog - total number of kits pending analysis for longer than the number of days specified

Numbers of Days from Release to Receipt in Lab – time span between the date that the survivor provided consent for forensic testing and the date that the Request for Laboratory Examination was created

Number of Days to Complete Forensic Analysis – time span between the date the Request for Laboratory Examination was created and the date the forensic testing was completed.

NOTE: Kits indicated as "analyzed" means that they have undergone forensic analysis and have returned to the appropriate law enforcement agency for storage.

Tracking System

The statewide SAK Tracking System provides sexual assault survivors with the ability to anonymously track the location and status of their SAK from the point of collection through forensic analysis to final storage location and possible destruction.

The WSP Crime Lab implemented the SAK tracking system, which included a pilot program followed by a phased rollout of the system. The pilot program began on February 2018 and statewide implementation completed October 2018.



Sexual Assault Kit Tracking System

Report Requirement

Second Substitute House Bill 2530, adopted during the 2015 regular legislative session, and required Washington State Patrol (WSP) to submit a semiannual report beginning on January 31st, on the statewide sexual assault kit tracking system to the Joint Legislative Task Force and the appropriate committees of the legislature on sexual assault forensic examination best practices.

This report contains the following as required:

Sexual Assault Kits (SAKs) Collected - total number of active collected kits. Kits that have been discarded are not included in this count

SAKs Collected without Consent for Forensic Testing - total number of kits that have been collected where the survivor has not provided consent for forensic testing

SAKs Discarded - total number of kits destroyed or removed from the tracking system

SAKS Analyzed – total number of kits that have undergone forensic analysis and returned to the appropriate law enforcement agency

Total Collected SAKs in the System – total number of collected kits, including those that have been discarded

SAKs Analysis Backlog - total number of kits pending analysis for longer than the number of days specified

Numbers of Days from Release to Receipt in Lab – time span between the date that the survivor provided consent for forensic testing and the date that the Request for Laboratory Examination was created

Number of Days to Complete Forensic Analysis – time span between the date the Request for Laboratory Examination was created and the date the forensic testing was completed.

NOTE: Kits indicated as "analyzed" means that they have undergone forensic analysis and have returned to the appropriate law enforcement agency for storage.

Tracking System

The statewide SAK Tracking System provides sexual assault survivors with the ability to anonymously track the location and status of their SAK from the point of collection through forensic analysis to final storage location and possible destruction.

The WSP Crime Lab implemented the SAK tracking system, which included a pilot program followed by a phased rollout of the system. The pilot program began on February 2018 and statewide implementation completed October 2018.
