DESCRIPTION:

On November 5, 2020, at approximately 1:03 AM, Waller was operating a 2005 Ford Pickup Truck when she struck a disabled vehicle on southbound Interstate 5 at Interstate 405. The driver of the disabled vehicle sustained life altering injuries. Waller and her passengers fled the scene on foot. Through investigative work Waller was identified as the driver of the truck and ultimately provided a full statement about the incident. Waller failed to appear for court and warrant for her arrest was issued.
