2024 WSU Live Fire Instructor Course Open Enrollment

This course provides an in-depth knowledge of NFPA 1403 principles and the Fire Training Academy's (FTA) Live Fire Policy. Students will gain a comprehensive knowledge of the FTA's procedures for conducting safe live fire training. Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to define the guidelines for conducting live-fire events at the FTA and describe the NFPA 1403 requirements that affect live fire training while identifying any legal requirements associated.

PREREQUISITES:

- Must be a current FTA Contracted Instructor or a Co-Op Live Fire Instructor

CLASS DATES:

Available via Washington State University (WSU) Online Extension.

Cost:

- \$84.00 per student

NOTES FOR STUDENTS:

- This course should be viewed using a Chrome browser.
 Any other browsers such as Safari or Firefox may cause glitches within the course.
- Each section contains a text reading and an attached PowerPoint. Make sure to review all of the materials within each section.
- You must pass each "self-check" quiz within each section with a 100% in order to proceed to the next section.
- You must pass the final exam portion with an 80% or higher. You will have TWO attempts to do so. After that, you will have to re-register for the course and take it again.
- Once registered, the student will have 7 days to complete the course. The course can be started and stopped as many times as you want within those 7 days.
- Once you have successfully completed the course, the certification is valid for 2 years.

REGISTRATION:

- 1. Click here to register.
- 2. Complete registration and submit payment for the course.
 - a. During the registration process, you will create a username, which will be the email address that you listed when registering for the course.
 - b. Registration may take up to 24 hours to finalize, but, it generally is ready in 4 hours.
- 3. Once your account has been created, follow this link.
- 4. Log-in using your email/username and password that was listed in your email confirmation of your registration.
- 5. Begin the course.
